The Hounds Club Policies

The Hounds Club provides a healthy, fun, and stimulating cage-free environment for dogs of all sizes and breeds. In order to help us keep the experience safe and exciting for all our guests, we ask that you please observe the following policies both before you come to visit us and when you are here at the Club.

- **Evaluation:** All dogs must be evaluated by our staff before their first stay at the Club. Evaluations are by appointment only. All breeds are welcome so long as they pass the evaluation test and remain good citizens.
- **Behavior:** All owners must certify that their dog has never shown signs of unprovoked aggression towards other dogs or people. If at any time a dog bites another dog or staff member, or in any way shows untoward aggression, that dog will no longer be able to attend the Club.
- **Health:** All dogs must be in good health and free from any condition that could potentially jeopardize the health of other dogs. Dogs that have been ill with a communicable ailment in the last 30 days will require veterinarian certification of health prior to being re-admitted to the Club.
- **Vaccinations and Parasite Prevention:** All dogs must remain up-to-date on all major vaccinations (Rabies, Distemper Combo and Bordetella aka Kennel Cough) and provide updated yearly documentation in a timely manner. Please note we require a 10 day incubation waiting period for all dogs who are receiving the Bordetella vaccine for the first time or are more than 6 months past due at the time of vaccination. Additionally, all dogs must be on a year round heartworm and flea prevention medication.
- **Ages of Note:** In order to attend, dogs must be over 4 months of age and have received at least two rounds of puppy vaccinations. All dogs over 6 months old must be spayed or neutered. After that age, for the safety of your dog and others, we cannot accept dogs that have not been neutered.
- **Dress Code:** For the safety of all guests and staff, dogs must arrive on a leash wearing an appropriate collar, ideally a flat quick-release snap-on collar. We cannot accept dogs with collars featuring prongs, spikes, jewels, or anything that might be damaged or cause harm to other dogs. If you do not have an appropriate collar, we carry a selection of quick-release collars in our retail section..

General Release

- I understand and agree that in admitting my dog(s) to The Hounds Club that The Hounds Club has relied on my representation that my dog(s) is/are in good health, has no contagious diseases and has/have not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog and that I have fully disclosed to The Hounds Club in writing all problems or characteristics of my dog(s) which may affect the handling and care of my dog(s) while at The Hounds Club including, but in no way limited to the information called for in this Form.
- I further understand that my dog may be injured or may cause injury to another dog. I understand the Hounds Club is a cage-free facility where accidents/injuries can happen and communicable diseases can be spread.
- I further understand that even though The Hounds Club requires every dog be vaccinated for Kennel Cough with the Bordetella vaccine, the vaccine does not protect my dog from every new strain of the virus. I further understand that being in a group environment highly increases the risk of contracting Kennel Cough, regardless of having the vaccine. I understand this risk and know that The Hounds Club assumes no responsibility for associated vet expenses.
- I further understand and agree that The Hounds Club and their staff/volunteers will not be liable for any problems that develop, except in the case of gross negligence or willful misconduct, and I hereby agree to release them and hold them harmless from any liability of any kind whatsoever arising from my dog(s) visitation and participation.
- I further understand that I am solely responsible for and agree to indemnify The Hounds Club from all liability incurred as a result of any injury and/or harm to a person or another dog caused by my dog(s) while visiting.

- I further understand and agree that any illness or injury that my dog(s) develop(s) while visiting The Hounds Club will be treated as deemed best by staff and volunteers of The Hounds Club and in their sole discretion, including choosing a suitable licensed veterinarian, and I assume full liability financial responsibility for any expenses involved. I give my consent and full authorization to The Hounds Club (including its agents and employees) to act in my behalf and in my dog(s) best interest, by choosing a veterinarian and obtaining emergency vet care at my expense if deemed necessary. I agree to indemnify and hold The Hounds Club (and its agents and employees) harmless for any and all expense relating to emergency care.
- I understand my dog may become dirty and matted during play and it is not the responsibility of The Hounds Club to prevent this.
- I further understand and agree that if my dog(s) is/are not picked up by the end of the regular business day, I hereby expressly authorize The Hounds Club to take whatever action is deemed necessary for the continuing care of my dog(s) and agree to pay all costs upon demand.
- I agree my dog(s) may be videotaped, photographed & recorded for unrestricted use in all media & promotions for The Hounds Club.
- The Hounds Club reserves the right to change, refuse or discontinue service to any dog at any time. If my dog's stay is terminated, I agree to promptly pick up my dog(s).
- I agree that any and all disputes that arise out of or relate to the subject matter of this agreement and/or in any way relate to my dog(s) and The Hounds Club shall be resolved by binding arbitration conducted by and pursuant to the rules of the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") in Los Angeles, CA. In this regard, I knowingly forego and waive any and all rights to trial by jury, to appeal or otherwise contest such resolution and further waive any right to seek emotional distress, loss of companionship and/or punitive damages. I further agree that the maximum amount of any claim against The Hounds Club and/or its employees and principals which in any way relates to my dog(s) and The Hounds Club shall be the lesser of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) or the cost to purchase a puppy of the same breed, comparable pedigree and sex of the dog(s) which is (are) the subject of such claim.
